RECENT GRANTS:

Since 2015, the Williamstown Fund for Excellence has granted more than \$100,000 to charitable endeavors in the Williamstown area (ie. geographical area served by the Williamstown Public School District). Recent grants include:

Building Bridges to Careers (BB2C): \$1000 to support program expansion into Williamstown.
