


Since 2008, PACF has grown assets 265% and made \$37+ million in grants, supported by generous donors*




*Note that in the year 2015 the Foundation made a large grant of nearly \$9M in assets to create two separate entities



AREAS TO WATCH

- Concern over earnings declines or recession as the Fed fights inflation with higher interest rates. Tight labor and sticky inflation may persist
- Reduced portfolio exposure to international and emerging markets in 2022 due to elevated risks
- Increased fixed income and cash due to attractive yields and equity risk
- Be nimble when opportunities arise (e.g. high yield, real assets)

Amidst increasing uncertainty, remain risk-diversified, and be prepared to invest opportunistically
